DRAFT FY2010 Senior Designated Housing Plan
ATTENTION SENIOR PUBLIC HOUSING RESIDENTS

The Chicago Housing Authority (CHA) has reviewed and made changes to its Senior Designated Housing Plan (SDHP). These policies govern the selection of senior housing units and developments owned by CHA. The CHA seeks to revise the parameters of the designation in order to: 1) increase leasing at senior designated properties with high vacancy rates, and 2) ensure that accessible units are provided to residents with disabilities who may benefit from the features.

The changes made to these policies are to ensure compliance with federal regulations and state and local laws, as well as to allow CHA to adopt or change housing management practices.

Public housing residents and the public may submit comments on the Draft SDHP during the public comment period. The 30-day comment period begins April 7, 2010 (8:00 a.m.) and ends May 6, 2010 (5:00 p.m.). All comments must be received by 5:00 p.m. on May 6, 2010. The proposed documents will be available for public review on CHA's website at www.thecha.org, as well as at the following locations:
