

Notice of Persons Appearing to Be Covered by the Relocation Rights Contract

The Chicago Housing Authority (CHA) is updating its list of leaseholders who lived in CHA housing on October 1, 1999 (10/1/99) and are covered by the Relocation Rights Contract (RRC). Under the RRC, 10/1/99 leaseholders have the right to return to a new mixed income or rehabilitated public housing unit if they have continuously followed the rules of their lease and currently meet other requirements. The CHA will allow persons who did not follow certain rules in their leases to cure their lease violations in order to maintain their right to return. For further information:

STEP 1: Look for your name on the Notice.

STEP 2: If your name is listed, complete and mail the inquiry form.

STEP 3: When we receive your notice, Globetrotters International will contact you with further information.
