COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKERS

According to local Labor Market Data, healthcare is one of five high demand industries in the Chicagoland area. To meet this demand, on January 9, 2024, the Workforce Opportunity Resource Center (WORC), in collaboration with the Council on Black Health (CBH), launched a 5 weekvirtual Community Health Worker (CHW) training for Chicago Housing Authority residents and Housing Choice Voucher participants. In total, ten residents andparticipants were selected out of sixty-seven applicants to begin the Community Health Worker training. A total of seven completed

100 core hours of didactic training and 80 hours of practicum/clinical hours to qualify for the Community Health Worker (CHW) Certification.
